1. Traffic Management



Whole Site Car Parking

Parking for LMDC Primary School and the Sixth Form Centre will remain separate to ensure smooth operation and minimise disruption.

Sufficient parking will be available on site on a first come, first served basis. The site provides a total of c.123 parking spaces. There are approximately 48 parking spaces for the LMDC Primary School and 75 for the Sixth Form Centre.

There is currently no distinct segregation of parking, although it is recognised that staff, students and visitors should park closest to the building in which they are based or visiting.

Vehicles parked on site at LMDC and in the additional offsite parking will be entirely at the owner's risk. The States of Guernsey will not accept liability for any damage or loss however caused.

The LMDC site is subject to a 5mph speed limit which must be adhered to at all times.

The following general rules relating the use of the whole site car parking must be followed at all times:

- Staff and students must hold a full valid driving licence.
- Staff and students may only park one vehicle on site at any time.
- Vehicles must not be left in the car park during leave/school holidays or at such other times when a vehicle's owner is not on site. Unless they have received prior agreement with the Principal and/or Head Teacher.
- Staff and student must not park in areas specifically designated for use by others.
- Bicycles and motorcycles should only be parked in designated parking areas and should not be left on the premises if not in frequent use.
- Students must have passed all required tests and hold a valid CBT (Compulsory Basic Training) certificate if bringing a motorcycle to site
- No parking is permitted by Sixth Form Centre staff or students in the Primary School drop-off/pick-up area at any time.
- Staff and students should not park in spaces designated for staff or customers of surrounding local business.
- Students' parking discs must be displayed at all times.
- No vehicles are permitted to be parked within 5m of the large white gas storage tanks.
- No vehicles are permitted to be parked in Clos des Mielles or other private properties/businesses.
- Control of parking for events both during and outside of core curriculum hours will be managed operationally between the two buildings

La Mare de Carteret Primary School – Staff, Parents, Visitors and Disabled Car Parking

The Primary school's parking, designated for staff and parents, will remain unchanged.

LMDC Primary parking is located along the front of the primary school up until the zebra crossing closest to the Sixth Form.

There is no parking on site for parents during the morning. A 'kiss and drop' method is carried out for morning drop off at approx. 08:20am to streamline and reduce traffic queues. This has been designed for quick entry and exit on the site during the peak period. Pick up time is 14:50pm for La Mare De Carteret Primary School with a traffic flow model followed.

Visitors to La Mare De Carteret Primary School will continue to park where there are spaces provided within the designated primary parking zone.

There are no disabled parking bays for La Mare De Carteret Primary School.

The Sixth Form Centre – Car Parking Plan

Figure 2 below presents the plans for parking at the Sixth Form Centre for staff, students, visitors as well as existing members of the Premises Team for the LMDC site.

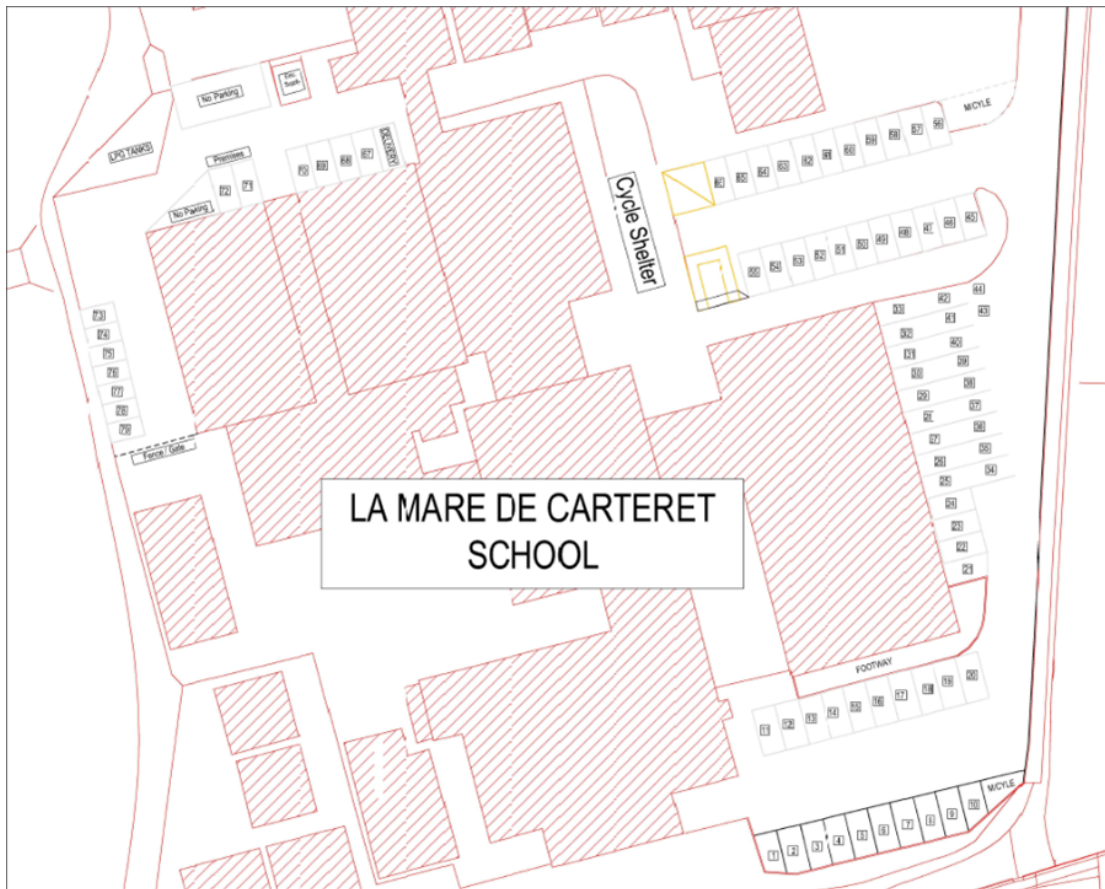


Figure 3: The Sixth Form Centre site parking

The Sixth Form Centre - Staff, Visitors and Disabled Car Parking

The Sixth Form Centre will have its own designated parking area, with assigned spaces for both staff and students, located separately from the La Mare De Carteret Primary School parking.

There will be 41 designated parking bays for staff and visitors, marked with white lines, 4 of which are reserved spaces for members of staff working across the SSP who will need to travel between sites, marked with red lines.

There will be 1 disabled parking bay for the Sixth Form Centre outside the main entrance to the Sixth Form Centre.

The Sixth Form Centre - Student Car Parking

There will be 36 designated parking bays for Sixth Form students, marked in yellow. These are located in the original bus turning point on the far side of the site. These spaces are lined as per Figure 14 above. All student car parking spaces will be subject to a car-sharing rule, where students will not be allowed to benefit from an on-site parking space without additional students travelling in their car.

Car-sharing signage will be in place and students will be regularly reminded of this rule through school communications.

Car parking permits will be issued to students upon application and will be actively monitored by the Sixth Form Centre to ensure adherence to parking rules. It should be noted that the speed limit on the site is 5 mph.

The Sixth Form Centre - Off-Site Parking

In addition to the parking facilities located on the school site, a tarmacked car park which can accommodate approx. 8-9 cars, along Route de la Mare de Carteret (Figure 16 below) and gravelled parking on Rue de la Saline, both adjoined to the LMDC Playing Field provides unofficial parking for cars and motorcycles. Neither car park is presently marked with any parking bays, potentially limiting the efficiency of parking. Signage will be located highlighting that the parking is reserved for students between 07:30 and 16:00 term time only. Any issues with parking in this location should be reported to the Principal in the first instance.

To note the gravelled parking on Rue de la Saline is not managed by Education, Sport and Culture and therefore any parking in this area would also be outside of the Sixth Form Centre's control and at the owners' own risk.

Motorcycle Parking

Motorcycles can be parked just inside the entrance to the main staff parking for the Sixth Form Centre (Figure 10 below) as well as in the designated motorcycle parking in the student parking area at the far side of the site (in Figure 8).

To drive on the public highway and park on site, students must have passed all required tests and hold a valid CBT (Compulsory Basic Training) certificate.

Whole Site Cycle Parking

Cycle parking is provided in various areas around the site, with dedicated cycle parking areas for La Mare de Carteret Primary School and Sixth Form Centre staff and students located outside their respective buildings.

La Mare de Carteret Primary School has dedicated covered cycle parking located next to the KS2 entrance. This is due to be repaired in the coming academic year.

The dedicated parking for the Sixth Form Centre can be used by both buildings, space permitted. This covered cycle parking allows for approx. 40 bikes to be stored.

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging

The site does not offer any electric vehicle charging points.

Cars and motor vehicles

The disabled and visitor parking spaces should be left vacant. Care should be taken to park within the marked lines of parking bays.

Sixth Form students must, under no circumstances, park their cars in spaces with white or red lines

Students arriving and leaving by car or bus

For arrival prior to the start of The sixth Form centre day, cars bringing students to school must drive to the far end of the site for students to enter via the cloisters

To enable the safe and smooth flow of traffic around our site and La Mare de Carteret Primary School, please can we remind you of the following arrangements:

- Any students being **dropped off** prior to 8:45 need to be dropped off site and can walk in, those being dropped off after 8:45 please follow directions from our premises team (who are special constables).
- All students being **collected** at the end of the school day also need to be picked up off site or parents / carers arriving after 3:40 please heed the directions with regards to suitable parking areas from the premises team.

Parking

Bicycles

These can be parked in the stands provided at the entrances to The Sixth Form Centre.

Motor-cycles and scooters

These should be parked in the assigned area. Particular care should be taken when entering and leaving the school car park.

Buses

The site is served by public bus routes with bus stops for services 41, 42, 91 and 92, all within reasonable walking distance of the site.

The public bus service 41 runs directly past the LMDC site, and the bus stop referred to as Rue de Galaad (in the bus timetable) is situated within the closest walking distance to the

school site, however, other bus stops and frequency of service within walking distance of the site are listed below:

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In addition to the public services, for the first year of the Sixth Form Centre's operation at the LMDC site, a small number of dedicated bus services for students will be provided.

In the mornings, Sixth Form students will be able to use Les Varendes High School bus services to get to Les Varendes. Those services are operated on behalf of The Committee *for the* Environment & Infrastructure by Stagecoach, Island Coachways and Island Taxis. Access to those services will be via the use of a QR code linked to a passenger management system, Shuttle ID. This enables load-balancing across services and also ensures that sufficient space is available for students on any shared services.

From Les Varendes, one or two (depending on demand levels) dedicated SFC express link morning service(s) will operate from the Footes Lane bus stop, which will serve as the primary hub.

The north of the Island will be provided with a dedicated SFC morning service, which will run mainly around the coast, including the Bridge.

Details of the services are available in Appendix 1.

In the afternoons, two vehicles will be assigned to the Sixth Form Centre, serving routes in the north (1B) and south/south-east (2B) of the Island, in particular the inland areas less accessible by direct public services.

LMDC Primary School will be served by dedicated morning and afternoons bus services [JW2] [EL3] [WJ4] for students within catchment. The minibus operating those services is planned to drop off/pick up from outside the front of the Primary School.

To note, all full-time students in Guernsey can travel for free on scheduled services with a [student puffin pass](#).

Pedestrian Access

Existing access is provided by the zebra crossing on the public highway outside of the school gates, onsite zebra crossings around the site and walkways with safety fencing
